3. Notification of entry must be submitted to the Boone County Extension Office by September 1, 2018. Phone 741-6168.
4. All booths are 4 ft. x 4 ft. No supplies will be provided for booths.
5. Junior exhibits should be constructed by youth involved with adult supervision only.
6. Exhibits may be put in place on Sunday, September 16 from 3:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. and must be removed between 2:00 p.m. and 3:00 p.m. Sunday, September 23. No other pick up time, please.
7. Booths will be judged on Monday, September 17.
8. The following premiums will be paid: blue ribbon – 20 points; red ribbon – 15 points; and white ribbon – 10 points.
9. Additional Premium will be paid for Overall Grand and Reserve
10. Electricity is available. **Switches and plugs must be easily accessible for building volunteers to turn on/off during building hours. Without easy accessibility, electricity will not be turned on daily or for judging.**
