Check-in will be Tuesday, September 22 from 7am-9am.

Poultry Chain show will begin at 9:30am

Breed Show to follow.

All animals must be removed from premises 2 hours after the conclusion of that show.

****All Poultry with the exception of waterfowl and pigeons MUST be Salmonella Pullorum-Typhoid tested prior to entering the fairgrounds. 90-day certificate needs to be present at check in or the birds will not be admitted into the building.**

All poultry will receive a health check upon check in. Any birds showing signs of illness or parasites will be asked to leave the premises.

Exhibitors are responsible for caring or arranging for care of their own poultry while in the barn.

This includes food, water, and clean-up. Exhibitors are NOT to feed or water other exhibitors' animals, if an animal is without feed or water, please contact the Poultry Superintendent.

Poultry is to be checked in and remain on exhibit until designated release time. Exceptions to check in or release time are at the discretion of the Poultry Superintendent. Removal of birds without Poultry Superintendents permission could result in premiums being withheld.

Poultry must be property of the exhibitors and in possession of the owner by entry deadline.

Champion and Reserve will be awarded for the following categories:

1. Standard (Large) Fowl
2. Bantam (Small) Fowl
3. Trio (Standard and Bantam Combined)
(Trio is a Cock and 2 Hens or a Cockerel and 2 Pullets)
4. Broilers (4H or FFA issued)
5. Poultry Chain (4H or FFA issued)
6. Waterfowl
7. Turkey
8. Exotic (Quail, Pheasant, etc)

Best in Show will be chosen from the Champions of the above categories.

Division A - Junior Class

Chicken Classes

1. Cock- Standard- Male Bird over 1 year
2. Cock- Bantam- Male Bird over 1 year
3. Cockerel- Standard – Male Bird under 1 year
4. Cockerel-Bantam- Male Bird under 1 year
5. Hen- Standard- Female Bird over 1 year
6. Hen-Bantam- Female Bird under 1 year
7. Pullet- Standard- Female Bird over 1 year
8. Pullet- Bantam- Female Bird under 1 year
9. Old Trio- Cock and 2 Hens
10. Young Trio- Cockerel and 2 Pullets
11. Poultry Chain Pullets- 4H/FFA
12. Commercial Broilers- 4H/FFA

Duck and Goose Classes

1. Old Drake- Male Bird over one year
2. Old Duck- Female Bird over one year
3. Young Drake- Male Bird less than one year
4. Young Duck-Female Bird less than one year
5. Old Gander- Male Goose over one year
6. Old Goose- Female Goose over one year
7. Young Gander-Male Goose under one year
8. Young Goose- Female Goose under one year

Turkey Classes

1. Old Tom- Male Bird over one year
2. Old Hen-Female Bird over one year
3. Young Tom- Male Bird under one year
4. Young Hen- Female Bird under one year

Exotic Classes

1. Guinea Fowl
2. Quail
3. Pheasant
4. Pigeon
