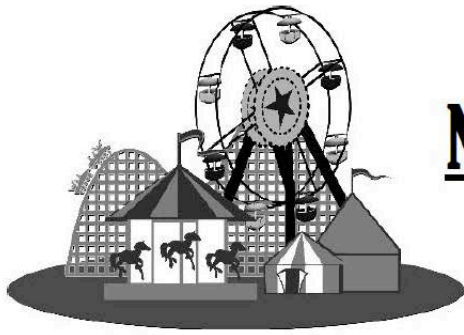
Arkansas Department of Health Directives Regarding Large Indoor Venues

The Secretary of Health, in consultation with the Governor, has sole authority over all instances of quarantine, isolation, and restrictions on commerce and travel throughout Arkansas, as necessary and appropriate to control disease in the state of Arkansas as authorized by Ark. Code Ann. 520-7-109—110. Based on available scientific evidence, it is necessary and appropriate to take further action to ensure that COVID-19 remains controlled and that residents and visitors in Arkansas remain safe.

Directives to follow while at the Northwest Arkansas District Fairgrounds:

- Please note: You are not allowed to enter facility if:
- You have fever, shortness of breath, sore throat, or loss of taste or smell.
- You have had a known exposure to someone with Covid-19 in the past 14 days.
- A venue may reopen for events up to 66 percent capacity for the facility with a plan approved by the Secretary of Health. Plans should be submitted to adh.ehs@Arkansas.gov.
- Fifty (100) people or fewer in attendance is allowed without a requirement to submit a plan.
- The performers/players/contestants must be separated from the audience by at least 12 feet and must be limited in number to fifty (50) or fewer.
- Seating must be arranged to maintain a 6-foot distance between members of the audience. Family groups may sit together but 6 feet should be maintained between groups.
- Every other row seating should be unoccupied to provide for 6 feet of physical distancing.
- Face coverings are required for all people present, except for children under 10 years of age, who are exempt.
- Performers/players/contestants may be without a face covering if they are 12 feet from other persons.
- Refreshments may be served. However, self-service operations, including, but not limited to, salad bars, buffets, and condiment bars shall not be allowed.
- Catered events are allowed with caterer-served buffets or plated meals..
- Seating must be arranged to maintain 10-foot physical distancing between tables so occupied seats are six feet from seats at adjacent tables. Please Wash Your Hands and use Hand Sanitizers.
