### 1. 1. Entry Fee

a. Junior Division: \$15b. Open Division: \$25

# 2. NO STRAW PERMITTED. ONLY SHAVINGS.

- 3. Animals entered in the breeding classes in the Junior Show must be registered in the exhibitor's name. Animals entered in the breeding classes in the Open Show can be registered in the Family OR Farm name.
- **4.** Registration certificates must be available for inspection at the show and ear tattoos will be verified prior to showing.
- 5. All Junior Breeding Beef must be owned by the exhibitor by July 15 of the current year.
- 6. All animals entered in the Breeding Classes are subject to mouthing. Animals found to be over age for its class will be banned from the show.
- 7. All heifers for the commercial show will be classified at the scales.
- 8. Only a 3/4% or more registered heifer or a 7/8% or more registered bull will be allowed to show in breed shows.
- 9. Registered composite animals may only show in one show (1) registered composite or commercial.

## 10. All placing values are point values

- 11. All breeds will be eligible to show.
- 12. Animals exhibiting in a beef show are not eligible to enter the alternative cattle show.
- 13. Bulls 12 months of age or older are required to exhibit with a nose ring

# Commercial & Market Beef (Junior)

- Heifers will be classified at the scales.
   Classes will be determined by type and/or weight.

- 3. There will be 2 general classes of Heifers, FIT OR NO FIT. **Appearance of Heifer when** presented at scales will determine the general class heifer will show.
- 4. Heifers in NO FIT must be slick shorn with hair NO LONGER THAN ¼ inch. Hair MUST BE trimmed at time of weigh-in. NO EXCEPTIONS! Any heifer not meeting this criteria will be placed in the FIT classes OR must be shaved and returned to scales before end of weigh-in. If no weight is recorded or do not meet the deadline, that entry will be considered forfeit. NO CLASS CHANGES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER WEIGH IN IS COMPLETED. No refunds will be given for failure to comply with the rules. Committee of 3 board members appointed by the fair board will determine any conflicts regarding compliance with this rule.
- 5. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Heifers will be picked from the Breed Champions and the Reserve Breed Champions.
- 6. Heifers can only exhibit in one show. Fit or No Fit.

### **BREED CLASSES**

- 7. American breed crosses (all heifers with a Brahman influence). Included will be Brahman,
  Santa Gertrudis, Brangus, Beefmaster, Braford, Simbrah, Brahmousin, Braler and any other breed
  of Brahman derivative or crosses from these breeds. Animals in the division should show some
  trait(s) of Brahman, such as ear, dewlap, rump, naval, etc.
- 8. European breeds and European breed crosses (all heifers with any "Exotic" breeding except those with Brahman blood). Included will be Charolais, Simmental, Limousin, Maine-Anjou, Chianina, Saler and any other breed originating on the European continent or commonly termed "Exotic". Animals in this division should have some indication of "Exotic" influence, either by color or form.
- 9. English breeds and English breed crosses. Included will be principally Angus, Hereford, Shorthorn and crosses thereof. Animals in this group should not show traits common to Brahman or European crosses. English breed crosses with Brahman or Exotic breeds will be classified as an American or European.
